

Greenville Board of Selectmen
Minutes of the Public Meeting
March 1, 2006

Present: Christine Deane, Michael Lamarre, Debbie Bouley

Carla Mary, Project Manger – Woodard & Curran

Carla reviewed the monthly reports for wastewater and water departments with the Board. She told the Board that the wastewater plant had a violation in January 2006 due to high flow on the 18th. She stated that this was a day with heavy rains and may be due to additional flow from Pilgrim Foods. Christine questioned who takes the readings at Pilgrim Foods and Carla told her that they take their own. Christine stated that she wants the town to take the readings to be sure they are accurate. Carla agreed to look into this more. Board is hoping after the I & I Study is complete that the town will have more information on where the additional flows are coming from. Carla reported that improvements were made to the heating system at the water plant. Health and safety inspections were done to both the wastewater and water plants by the Safety Inspector of Woodard & Curran. Carla told the Board that they must comply with OSHA and that the issues raised are being addressed and will be corrected. A copy of this report is on file in the office as well as the Monthly Operating reports.

Pilgrim Foods – Charles Santich and Doug Skeen

Board inquired if everyone reviewed the wastewater discharge permit for 2006. Everyone had and there were no questions or problems. Pilgrim Foods and Carla Mary agreed to work together to test samples from the plant in order to get faster results. Carla stated that Pilgrim Foods needs to take daily flow readings. Doug Skeen agreed to do this on business days. Charles Santich stated that he would not be willing to agree to the new permit until he knows what the new rates will be. Christine stated that the commercial rates have not changed in a number of years and the Board has not made the final decision as to what the new rates will be. She stated that Pilgrim Foods will be notified by mail when they have made their decision. As for the discharge permit, the only signatures required are that of the Sewer Commissioners. Board agreed and signed the permit for 2006.

Commercial Sewer Rates

Board reviewed the current formula used to calculate the sewer bills for Pilgrim Foods. An adjustment was made as follows: rate for bod = (current year budget X 35%) / annual loading; tss = (current budget x 35%) / annual loading; flow = (budget x 60%) / (annual flow/1,000). This rate will take effect on the next billing.

Letter from Rick Miller – Ice Skating Rink

Board received a letter from Rick Miller concerning his interest in having an ice skating rink in Greenville. Board will send a letter to Mr. Miller agreeing that it would be nice to have a rink in town again, thank him for volunteering to assist and advise him that there is a position open on the Parks & Recreation Committee if he would like to serve.

Note from Dennis Heywood – Overtime for water break

Dennis Heywood, Road Agent, requested to be paid for 3 hours overtime due to a water break. He stated that this was over his 40 hours (total hours for week 55) and feels this is something he should be compensated for. Board agreed that as he is a salaried employee he can take any time over the 40 hours worked

DOT Permit

Board signed permit with DOT to allow Pelletier to install water lines down Route 31.
