

Greenville Board of Selectmen
Minutes of the Public Hearing Town Hall Study
January 3, 2007

Hearing opened at 7:00 p.m. Presenters were Richard and Duffy Monahon, Architects. Others present: Rick Miller, James Lambert, Andy Mackey, Marshall Buttrick, Dick Wallace.

R. Monahon stated that the final project, bound and colored will be submitted to the Board at another meeting. He then went over the proposed changes and work that would need to be done. D. Monahon stated that by using the basement level it meets the ADA requirements of access and designed so that there are two means of egress. R. Monahon showed how the lift would run from the basement to the 2nd level. He also stated that they are recommending a sprinkler system for the building, they feel this is the most cost efficient means of complying with code. A stairwell will run from this floor down to the basement as a 2nd means of egress, as well as the lift. R. Monahon stated that the cost estimate was \$1,185,206, this is broken down by each item and is attached to these minutes. Where to proceed from here was then discussed with the next step being to hire an Architect to draw up the plans and then funding. M. Buttrick asked for a summary sheet of their report so that it can be included in the town report. R. Monahon stated that he will prepare such a report.
