

Greenville Board of Selectmen
Minutes of the Public Meeting
January 3, 2007

Members present: Mike Lamarre, Debbie Bouley

Meeting opened at 6:30 pm

Fire Department – 2007 Budget

Larry Legere presented a proposed lease for a new fire engine. The committee looked at several bids and came up with this proposal, finding it to be the best offer. The cost is \$250,293 with \$60,000 from expendable trust and final cost \$190,293. This amount to be leased from First Bankers and the towns' first payment of \$26,156.80 due December 2008. The value of the truck is \$262,293. \$12,000.00 will be credited towards equipping the truck with the foam and complete setup. Board agreed to place this as a warrant article in 2007. The Fire Department 2007 proposed budget of \$85,650 will be placed in the operating budget. L. Legere stated that they are recommending changing the article for a roof to repairs for the building. He will get together with L. Langille to word both articles. Board agreed.

Board recessed their regular meeting to hold the Public Hearing on the Town Hall Study. (see the minutes for details)

Board resumed regular meeting at 9:25 p.m.

Letter from Anne McInnis – Playground

Board received a letter from Anne McInnis in reference to a grant the elementary school received for health and fitness and want to know if the town is interested in joining with them to put a track in at the town ballpark. Board agreed to set up a meeting with Anne to discuss this further.

Floor in meeting room restroom

Linda told the Board that the floor tiles in the restroom of the meeting room need to be replaced, tiles are broken and there is a hazard someone will get hurt. She tried to obtain 3 quotes for the work but could only get one from Whirlwind. Other companies contacted said that it was too small a job for them to take on at this time. Quote was for \$685.66 plus additional expense should the sub-floor need replacing. Board authorized the repair.

Letter from Alden Greenwood – PILOT program

Board received a letter from Alden Greenwood along with a contract for a PILOT program for his hydro plants. Board agreed to send this contract to Town Attorney for advice as well as Avitar Assessing. After advice from them the Board will set up another meeting with Mr. Greenwood.
