

Greenville Board of Selectmen
Minutes of the Public Meeting
March 28, 2007

Members present: Debbie Bouley, Mike Lamarre, Scott Blease

Meeting opened at 7:00 pm

Woodard & Curran – Steve Niro, Paul Roux, Carla Mary

Carla presented a breakdown of the 2006 repairs and maintenance (R&M) budget for both plants. She stated that a lot of the expenses are for contracted services. Some are for expansion tanks and prv repairs, as we have now put these expenses to the homeowner we will not see this expense in the R&M budget again. Carla also submitted an overview of anticipated expenditures for 2007, these are included in their 2007 budget. Paul stated that the past 5 years it has been budgeted at a total for both plants at \$20,000, this has been increased in 2007 to \$24,050. Carla stated that each monthly report contains the R&M budget expenses. Steve Niro stated they are willing to forgive 2006 overage and there will be better tracking done from here on. Paul stated that anything over \$1,000 is considered capital, so they identify this with the Board and deal on it a case by case basis.

Carla submitted a report of the violations that Pilgrim Foods has had over the past few months with discharging over the limit. Discussion pertained to the problems this creates at the plant and possibility of facing violations. Paul stated that the lagoons have a lot of sludge in them and they are not working properly. Mike questioned whether the amount they discharge should be changed. Carla stated no, they just need to be alert to what their bod numbers are and what they are sending, when high they need to limit the amount they send at a time. Paul stated that typically a contract will have a surcharge for any time there is a violation of the amount of bod or tss's that are discharged.

Discussed the invoice from W&C on the sludge holding tank. Paul stated that they had incurred engineering cost on this project. Paul will check with Engineer to see if the cost can be reduced. It was agreed that the portion of the invoice submitted by Knowles will be cut in half. Paul stated that they would need to have a cat walk and safety rail around the area. Board will check with Dennis to see if the highway department can remove the concrete. A final decision will be made at the next meeting to determine what will be paid on this invoice.

Board questioned about the discharge permit with DES and that it has expired. Paul stated that in September 2006 the State sent a package out and the paperwork was completed and returned to them. We are awaiting a response from DES.

Pilgrim Foods – Charles Santich, Doug Skeen, Armid

Mike discussed with them the violations in January & February with the discharge to the plant. Doug stated that he thought they were working together to draw down the lagoons. Carla stated that she wants it in writing when they are going to discharge more, what the bod's and tss's are and for what duration they will be doing this. Doug also stated that he wants it in writing when they are not working with the town. Mike stated that it needs to

be included in the permit that Pilgrim Foods needs to give written notice of needing to discharge more.

Water issues – Doug stated it is not dirty water but there are organics in the water and customers are complaining of the taste. He said he spoke with Jay Crystal at Chemserve and Dick Travers at Barklay Chemical. Doug was told by them there are some chemicals that can take the organics out of the water. Charlie said that the water does not taste very well and is affecting some of their products. Mike questioned what is the town's requirement to supplying the water. Paul stated that it must meet certain standards, which it does. Doug asked if they could look at cleaning up the organics and the possibility of a commercial rate. Mike stated that if they get a reduced rate they are in essence asking the other users to subsidize their cost. It was agreed that Pilgrim Foods and Woodard & Curran would compare water samples and see if they can determine what the organics are and if it can be corrected. Charlie asked if they could meet at least quarterly with the Board and Woodard & Curran. It was agreed.

Mike stated that they need to complete the discharge permit. It was agreed that Doug and Carla will meet at Pilgrim Foods to finalize this permit on Monday April 2, 2007 at 9:30 am.

Motion by Mike, second by Debbie to enter into non-public session concerning a personnel matter. Motion carried.

Board entered non-public session at 9:40 pm.

Board resumed open session at 10:00 pm. Motion made by Mike, second by Debbie to seal the minutes of the non-public session. Motion carried.
