Minutes of the Public Meeting
April 11, 2007

Meeting opened at 7:00 p.m.

Motion made by Debbie, second by Mike to enter into non-public session with Dennis Heywood concerning personnel matters. Motion carried and board entered non-public session at 7:05 p.m.

Board resumed open session at 8:30 p.m. and voted to seal the minutes of the non-public session.
