

# **Greenville Board of Selectmen**

## **Minutes of the Public Meeting**

**May 9, 2007**

Members present: Debbie Bouley, Mike Lamarre, Scott Blease

### **Ed White – Fire Department**

Ed told the Board that the fire department would like to hold a firemen's muster this year and he has contacted the Parks & Rec Committee and spoke with Anne McInnis. She told him that he should go to their meeting on the 17<sup>th</sup> to approach the full committee. She stated that after speaking with them they did not want them to use the field with all the work they have put into the field. Ed told the Board that they will do some damage to the grass, if the materials are supplied to them they will repair the field. Debbie asked if they know what the baseball schedule is and will they be able to get the field back to its original state before the next game. Ed said that they would not be using the area where the kids are playing ball. He wants to know if they have the support of the Selectmen. Larry stated that he spoke with Rick Miller, Parks & Rec member, concerning this event and he stated that his only concern was the trucks on the field to install poles. Larry stated that this was not going to be done, Rick seemed to think that this will be okay. Board unanimously agreed to support this event with the agreement that the Fire Department will repair the field after the event if the materials are available. Parks & Rec committee arrived and Debbie informed them of their decision to allow the muster, with no water poles, and they will repair the field after the event.

### **Larry Legere - Fire Department**

Larry informed the Board that the pull station in town are in need of repair. Some of the work has been done but there is still some work needed. The pull box on Rousseau Hill will replace the one on Mill Street. There is also an issue with having the whistle blow properly. He would like permission to take this money from the Communication Expendable Trust Fund to do the repairs as this communications related, cost approximately \$3,800. Motion made by Scott to authorize the fire department to have the pull box repairs done and to use the funds from the Communication Equipment Expendable Trust, second by Mike. Motion carried unanimously.

In reference to the old rescue truck he stated that they need to put it out to bid. The newer rescue needs to be finished and he wanted permission to have this done. Larry stated that he is not able to obtain additional bids as no one will do all the work needed as this one quote was for but he would need to take it to several different vendors. Board agreed to have the work done.

### **Parks & Recreation Committee**

Members present: Rick Miller, Anne McInnis, Carol Stanley, Marie Bradley and Diane Barney

Further discussion was held pertaining to the muster. The Fire Department was invited back in and was told that they would need to supply the materials needed, such as seed and that they would need to water it after. Ed stated that as there is cost now involved he will need to speak with the Fire Chief.

Anne told the Board that Marie is an excellent director and is now on light duty due to some shoulder surgery. They would still like to hire her for the season to run the facility. Marie stated that she has help from the guards and others that can assist with the lifting and she will be able to assume the remainder of her duties. Board asked her to get a note from her doctor of her restrictions.

Anne told the Board that they have set a plan for things to do for the summer. Diane is interested in doing more things at the field other than the pool. They are going to meet with the police to try to get them to have more interaction with the kids and patrol of the area. Scott told her that the pole at the playground was installed by PSNH free of charge to the town and it should be working. Anne said she will look into this and have the light working again and that she will check with Dennis to see if there is a schedule to emptying the trash at the playground. Marie updated the Board on the lifeguards, there are some coming back and 2 new ones. Pool is scheduled to open June 22 after school.

### **Keller Property**

Board went to the Keller property on Adams Hill to check on the landscaping work that was done by the town. There are issues that need to be addressed. Board will invite Dennis Heywood and Carla Mary to a meeting to discuss this issue further.

### **Kelly Vokey and Leo Carr – Butternut Hill Road drainage**

Leo Carr stated that they are having a problem with water coming from Butternut Hill Road onto their property and also Dorothy Morgan, also present at the meeting. Board will bring it up with the town engineer that is going back up there for the proposed project. Mr. Carr stated that since the Livingston Road project was done and the road was paved it has created this problem. Debbie will speak with the Planning Board to be sure that this drainage issue is addressed before the mylars are signed off on.

### **Richard Monahan, Architect – Town Hall**

Town Hall Committee members present: Wally Wallace, Pat Wallace  
Richard Monahan had a draft owner architect agreement to review with the Board. He stated that most towns have their attorney review it. He told the Board that they recommend hiring a Contract Manager to oversee the project and work with them in the planning stages. Board reviewed the proposed agreement with Mr. Monahan. Mr. Monahan will have the contract typed and submitted to the Board for their final review, the review of Town Attorney and then their signature. He stated that he will begin work without the signed contract and scheduled a meeting with the Town Hall Building Committee for Monday, May 21 at 7 p.m. He also requested a \$2,000 deposit to get the work started.

### **Fire Trust Expendable Trust**

Motion made by Mike to take \$60,000 from the Fire Expendable Trust fund to put towards the purchase of the fire truck, second by Debbie. Motion carried unanimously.

**Speed Limit on Barrett Road**

Linda told the Board that a resident of Barrett Road requested that speed limit signs be posted on their road. Board agreed and will have Dennis install a 30 mph speed limit on both ends of the road.

**Sewer Holding Tanks**

Board received a quote that was obtained by Dennis Heywood for the work to be done at the sewer holding tanks. They are requesting that Dennis get one additional quote.

**Boiler at Water Plant**

Carla left a message that the boiler at the water plant is down and needs some repairs. She believes that the unit is still under warranty and will check on the vendor. Carla did receive one quote to repair the unit at \$1,500.
