

Greenville Board of Selectmen
Minutes of the Public Meeting
July 25, 2007

Meeting opened at 7 pm

Carla Mary, Project Manager – Woodard & Curran

C. Mary presented a proposal the Board to have the planks at the wastewater plant replaced. She has the cost estimated at \$4 – 5,000. If Board wants her to she will continue to pursue this project and a more definite cost. Board authorized her to go forward.

C. Mary submitted a purchase order to chlorine analyzer for the water treatment plant in the amount of \$2,775. Board authorized the expenditure from the Water Equipment Expendable Trust Fund.

The water lagoons were discussed. C. Mary obtained quote to have the waste trucked for one lagoon at a cost of \$4,700 and the cost to build a ramp to lagoon, truck in required gravel for ramp, dig sludge out and load in truck, remove ramp, and loam & reseed at \$23,060. Board does not have the funds appropriated to do the work this year but will put a warrant article in for 2008 for \$35,000.

Board also will put a warrant article in 2008 for the water tank on Adams Hill Road which needs to be addressed.

Communication Expendable Trust

Board authorized the expense for the purchase of batteries and microphones for the new radios to come from the Communication Expendable trust.

Lashua – Junk Yard License Renewal

Board approved the annual Junk Yard renewal for Burton Lashua with the condition that he comes into compliance with all state regulations by 2008.

Trash & Dumpster By-law

Board adopted a by-law regulations trash and dumpsters on town properties, effective August 8, 2007. A copy of this by-law can be found on the town's web page and in the town clerk's office.
