Minutes of the Public Meeting

September 5, 2007

Held at Temple Town Building

Board of Selectmen discussed the following issues with Chief McTague after the Joint Police Board meeting.

Police Station Garage Door

Chief McTague gave the Board 2 quotes on replacing the door on the police station. After reviewing Board requested that he obtain a 3rd quote from RG Tombs. Chief will do so and bring them back to the Board.

Dog Kennel

Chief McTague gave the Board 3 quotes for materials for the dog kennel. They were: Currier Lumber - \$1,500 Milford Lumber \$1,200 and Belletetes \$1,300. Motion made by Scott, second by Mike to authorize the purchase of materials for dog kennel from Milford Lumber and Belletetes (split). Motion carried. Chief stated Highway Department is assisting with the labor.

Parking

Chief McTague told the Board that he has some suggestions on the parking issues on Main Street in Greenville. He recommended that the town put a one hour limit on Main Street with permits given to those who work in the building as needed, for senior citizens, or others as needed. He also stated that the lot owned by the town could be used as parking spaces for business owners, give a permit per business to park there. Board agreed to add this to their agenda for future discussion and possibility of writing an ordinance. Discussion was also held pertaining to winter parking ban and this will be discussed at the next meeting further. No final decisions were made.
