

Greenville Board of Selectmen
Minutes of the Public Meeting
October 10, 2007

Melissa and Michael Courtney – mailing address

Melissa explained to the Board that they moved to a home on Chamberlin Street in 2003, she has made several attempts at the town hall to have her address changed to receive water bills and never received them. She has now received notice that there is now a tax lien on her property. They understand that they have to pay the water bills, but would like to have the interest and fees removed as they attempted to have the address change. Their correct mailing address was provided at this meeting. Interest and penalties totaled \$1,129.75. Motion made by D. Bouley, second by M. Lamarre, to give Mr. & Mrs. Courtney \$1,129.75 in interest and penalties. Plus the interest and penalties for 2004. Motion passed unanimously.

2008 Budgets

Board set the following 2008 budgets: Legal - \$5,000; Capital Reserve - \$25,000; and Expendable Trust Funds - \$94,000.

Paving Bids

Dennis Heywood submitted 2 additional bids for paving. The Board had requested 3 additional bids but Dennis was only able to obtain 2. Board reviewed all bids submitted and voted to award the bid to Thibodeau paving in the amount of \$31,900. Board wanted it noted that this is not to include any highway personnel assistance on this project, only Dennis Heywood as a supervisor.

Ordinances

D. Bouley discussed with Board the loitering ordinance. Board agreed to amend the ordinance to add that within in one week time frame 2 warning will be given and the 3rd offence individual(s) will be arrested. On the Pooper Scooper Ordinance the Board agreed to amend the ordinance to add a fine will be issued if a complaint is filed with the Police Department, or if witnessed by an Officer.
