Adams Hill Water Tank

Toby Fedder told the Board that he has reviewed the prior inspection. Discussion was held on the options for the town, one being taking the Adams Hill tank off-line. T. Fedder said that there is sufficient storage in town allowing for this to be done. It was stated that test would need to be done for the flow with the tank off-line. T. Fedder also stated that the additional testing of the tank should be done to see if there is lead, this would cause DES to come in and require repairs be done. T. Fedder stated that the town would want to get the Fire Department involved in testing of taking the tank off-line to be sure that they have sufficient water for a fire. P. Roux asked what DES would be looking at for approval of the town to take the tank off-line. T. Fedder stated that he does not think they will have any issues with it as long as safety is met. Cost for engineering on the construction of a new tank would be \$10 – 12,000 and this would be much less to take the tank down. C. Mary and T. Fedder will get the flow testing done within the next month.
