

**Greenville Board of Selectmen**  
**Minutes of the Public Meeting**  
**December 5, 2007**

**Kathy Valliere – Tax Collector Budget**

K. Valliere submitted a budget of \$56,724. During review it was agreed to cut Tax Collector Salary to \$29,702 and leave the increases for the Deputies; retirement line was adjusted to \$2,596 to reflect change in salary line item. Total budget approved was \$56,423.

**Kathy Valliere – Town Clerk Budget**

K. Valliere submitted a budget of \$44,036. During review it was agreed to cut Deputy Town Clerk salary line item to \$7,500 as K. Valliere agreed to take the additional \$250 from her fee line item; election supplies was increased to \$360 to cover lunches during elections. Total budget approved was \$44,001.

**Marcel Bernier – Emergency Management Budget**

M. Bernier presented a budget of \$5,000. He stated that he is applying for a grant to purchase a computer and printer, this is a matching grant. Budget approved as submitted.

**Town Assistance Budget**

Christine Lavery submitted a budget of \$38,000, same as 2007 with the line item changes of moving \$600 from rent to salary. During review the Board and Committee made the following changes: rent - \$15,000; electricity - \$2,000; heat - \$7,500; medical - \$1,500. Total budget approved was \$30,800.

**Chief James McTague – Police Department**

Chief McTague discussed with the Board a Stand-alone Greenville Police Budget stating that there would be no savings for Greenville as they would need to maintain the same services, equipment, etc unless the town wanted to cut back and reduce services to the town.

The construction of the dog kennel was discussed. Chief McTague stated that he received a quote from a contractor to put up the kennel for \$22,000. He suggested to the town that the work be done themselves and only need to pay for materials. The highway department has since been doing the work on the kennels. Scott Blease expressed concern over the amount of time that it is taking to get the work done and the cost to the town. Chief stated that the kennel is approximately 95% complete.

It was agreed that work on the kennel would stop at this point until spring, however materials will be ordered. It was also agreed that only one employee from the highway dept would continue to assist the Chief to accomplish the electrical work and verified by D. Baldinelli as an electrician.

Discussion was held concerning the replacement of the garage door at the police station. Board approved the quote for the purchase of the door and allowed one employee from the highway department to assist in the framing.

Board showed Chief McTague the sidewalk ordinance as drafted by Attorney Mullins. Chief stated that he will enforce this ordinance as long as he gets the support from the Board of Selectmen and that it is for all roads in the town. Board agreed. Ordinance becomes effective January 1, 2008.
