

**Greenville Board of Selectmen**  
**Minutes of the Public Meeting**  
**January 9, 2008**

Members present: Debbie Bouley, Mike Lamarre, Scott Blease

Budget Committee members present: Tom Barrett, Rick Miller, Rose Thibault, Shirley Winslow

Budget Committee and Selectmen reviewed the proposed 2008 warrant articles as follows:

1. \$39,276 for reconstruction and paving town roads (offset by Highway Block Grant) – T. Barrett questioned what roads would be done this year. It was stated that D. Heywood would be requested to submit a list of those roads prior to Budget Hearing. Motion made by T. Barrett, second by S. Winslow to recommend this warrant article. All voted in favor.
2. Vote to adopt the most current International Building Code – Motion made by T. Barrett, second by S. Blease to recommend this warrant article. All voted in favor.
3. \$40,000 to clean the lagoons at the water treatment plant – this article will be discussed at the January 30 meeting with Carla Mary.
4. \$5,000 for an expendable trust fund known as Wastewater Collection Repair and Maintenance Fund. Noted to change wording of the article to read "... maintenance to the wastewater pump station and collection system...". Motion made by T. Barrett to recommend this warrant article as changed, second by R. Miller. All voted in favor.
5. \$20,000 for repairs to the wastewater pump station – this article will be discussed at the January 30 meeting with Carla Mary.
6. Vote to change the position of Treasurer from elected official to appointed position. Question was raised as to whether the current Treasurer was aware of this article and Linda stated that he was. It was also questioned as to whether this would increase the amount of the salary and then include benefits. Board stated that there would not be any changes as this would remain a part time position. Motion made by T. Barrett, second by R. Thibault to recommend this warrant article. All voted in favor
7. To enter into a 5 year inter-municipal agreement with the town of Temple for police coverage. Question raised as to whether the selectmen were satisfied with the joint department. All members stated that they have both positive and negative feelings about the merger. Also questioned what to why the term changed from 3 years to 5 and D. Bouley explained that as there is a clause in the agreement that allows either town to end the agreement at any time there was no reasons as to why to keep repeating the agreement every 3 years. Motion made

by T. Barrett, second by R. Miller to recommend this warrant article. All voted in favor.

8. Adopt the provisions of RSA 41:14-a and authorize the selectmen to acquire or sell land, buildings or both; provided that they shall first submit any such proposed acquisition or sale to the planning board and to the conservation commission for review and recommendations. L. Langille explained that this was an article to clean up one that was voted on last to create an expendable trust to purchase land for the fire department. The selectmen do not currently have the authority to do and need it from town meeting. Question was raised as to whether there would be a public hearing prior to the purchase or sale of any land. It was explained that they are required by law. Motion made by R. Miller, second by T. Barrett to recommend this warrant article. All voted in favor.
9. Vote to designate the selectmen as agents to expend the existing new fire station capital reserve fund. L. Langille explained that this article goes along with the article stated above and is for clarification purposes. Motion made by T. Barrett, second by S. Winslow to recommend this warrant article. All voted in favor.

T. Barrett stated that he is questioning how well the joint meeting between the selectmen and the budget committee is going as only 1 department has come in and offered a savings to the town. He is concerned that he expenses are going up too much and departments are trying to save money for the town. R. Miller offered that the budget committee assist the selectmen more in findings savings. S. Winslow stated that the committee should meet earlier to get more involved. Selectmen stated that they would like to see more help from the committee in finding cost savings and working with departments. It was decided that the budget committee would set up a time to meet on their own, elect officers and report back to the selectmen.

#### Building Inspector

Discussion was held that as the current Building Inspector may be seeking to retire in the near future the town should be looking at what can be done. It was agreed that the town needs an enforcer of the codes and town ordinances and should look into sharing a person with another town.

#### Street Light Committee

Members present were: Shirley Winslow, Rose Thibault and Charles Buttrick  
Rose Thibault told the Board that they have reached an agreement with PSNH to change, remove and move street lights in town for a cost of \$44,514, which include up to \$1,000 for traffic control by another vendor. After review of the agreement a motion was made by S. Blease, second by M. Lamarre to proceed with the agreement as presented and recommended by the Street Lighting Committee in the amount of \$44,514. All voted in favor. Board gave authority to L. Langille to sign the necessary purchase order required by PSNH.

#### Police Officer

D. Bouley stated that at the joint Police Committee meeting they were advised by Chief McTague that Officer M. Needham was being changed to part-time status and could not work until cleared by the Police Academy due to the number of hours he has worked. Chief recommended replacing Officer Needham's full-time position with part-time Officer Vint Boggis. Board agreed to the change in status of Officer Boggis with the

agreement that he will not be taking any health benefits and should he every decide that he needs them his salary will be renegotiated at that time.

Next Meeting

Due to two members of the Board of Selectmen being out of town on January 23 that meeting will rescheduled to January 30.
