

**Greenville Board of Selectmen**  
**Minutes of the Public Meeting**  
**January 30, 2008**

Members present: Debbie Bouley, Mike Lamarre, Scott Blease

Inventory of Taxable Properties

Motion made by D. Bouley, second by M. Lamarre to discontinue the requirement of Inventory of Taxable Property filings. Motion carried. This will take effect in 2009.

Budge Committee Members present: Tom Barrett, Rose Thibault, Shirley Winslow, Rick Miller and Ted deWinter.

Carla Mary & Toby Fedder - Adams Hill Tank

Toby Fedder told the Board that they would need to look at a 1 year abandonment of the tank before anything can be done to it. They can get approval from DES and get the specs to have the work done. After the bids come in with the price to take the tank down the town would then have the decision to do the work or just abandon it. He stated that the town does not need permission from DES to just shut the line off and abandon the tank temporarily. The cost of \$24,000 is to cover getting the documents to DES and getting ready for the bid. Motion made by M. Lamarre, second by S. Blease to take the Adams Hill Tank off line in the spring 2008 and see what happens to the system in a year and then determine if this is a permanent shut off that the town wants to keep. Motion carried.

Carla Mary – Water/Wastewater Budget and Articles

The following were reviewed – Anthracite – additional \$2,018 added to the line item in the water budget; lagoon cleaning at the water plant was postponed until next year; sewer jetter – article for \$14,852; lime system set-up – article for \$7,065; shipping container – article for \$6,900.

C. Mary asked the Board if a decision had been made how to handle the property on Mill Street that the sewer line needs to be repaired and homeowner cannot afford to have it done. No decision has been made.

C. Mary submitted to the Board for their review and approval a Grease Management Program. Board asked to her to try to condense the document and make it easier for property owners to understand.

Miscellaneous

Board signed a management letter authorizing Melanson, Heath & Co. to perform the 2007 audit.

Pilgrim Foods Warrant for septic discharge 7/1/07 through 12/31/07 was signed.

Selectmen's Narrative for the 2007 annual report was completed.

Abatement for Troy Morse was approved and signed by the Board.

Veterans Credit application submitted by Kevin Burt was approved.

Purchase order submitted by the Fire Department for repairs to valves on the pump of the ladder truck in the amount of \$1,140 was approved.
