

Greenville Board of Selectmen
Minutes of the Public Meeting
March 26, 2008

Members present: Scott Blease, Kathy Washburn, Brenda Bergeron

Meeting opened at 6:30 p.m.

Linda Langille asked for a non-public session to discuss a personnel issue and asked that Kathy Valliere be present at the meeting.

Motion made by Scott Blease, second by Kathy Washburn to enter into non-public session for a personnel issue at 6:30 pm . Motion carried.

Board resumed open session at 6:50 pm and voted to seal the minutes of the meeting.

Kathy Valliere – Treasurer position

Kathy Valliere told the Board that she wanted their permission to open a checking account for her to make deposits into for property taxes, water and sewer. She will then issue a check to the town treasurer for those amounts. The auditors have requested that this be done to stop the problems with transferring funds between accounts. B. Bergeron questioned what would go into this account – water sewer and taxes. Motion made by B. Bergeron, second by S. Blease to give Kathy Valliere the authority to open an account for the town of Greenville to deposit and write checks for property taxes, water and sewer second by K. Washburn. Motion carried.

Zebadiah Kellogg-Roe was present at this meeting and told the Board that he was here to offer his help if needed until a new Treasurer could be found and train the new person as well. Board thanked him for his offer.

Bernie & Diane Leblanc – 44 Pleasant Street

Bernie Leblanc stated that he is looking to resolve an issue with their neighbor Mr. Tirrell. Mr. Tirrell had an appointment with the Planning Board to have a 3rd apartment but did not show up so the Planning Board told the Leblanc's to meet with the Selectmen. They said that there is still someone living in the 3rd apartment. Board asked Linda Langille to speak with Don Baldinelli and have him check the apartments, check if building permits were issued for decks, entrances, check the set backs and report back to selectmen. Mr. Leblanc gave permission for Don Baldinelli to go on their property if needed.

Christian Lund – School Board

Board received a letter from Christian Lund of the School Board to meet with him and the New Ipswich Board of Selectmen to discuss the organization of a new SAU. Board told Linda Langille to call Mr. Lund and tell him that they will meet either the 1st or 3rd Wednesday of the month, preferably in Greenville.

Purchase Orders

S. Blease asked Linda Langille to put on the agenda for tonight's discussion whether purchase orders should be issued for sand and salt, they previously were not requested.

S. Blease stated that there is a sufficient supply of both at the highway garage at this time and they should not need to purchase any more. When they would he wants to see more than one quote. Board agreed to have Linda Langille ask Dennis Heywood what his plans are on purchasing additional sand and salt and what his supply currently is.

Appointments for 2008

Board signed appointments for Beautification Committee, Conservation Commission, Emergency Management Director, Fire Chief, Fire Station Study Committee, Holiday Committee, Parks & Recreation Committee, Planning Board and Zoning Board of Adjustment.
