

Greenville Board of Selectmen
Minutes of the Public Meeting
July 9, 2008

Members present: Scott Blease, Kathy Washburn, Brenda Bergeron

Meeting opened at 7:00 pm

Carla Mary, Project Manager – Water and Wastewater Monthly Operating Reports

C. Mary went over the monthly operating reports for the water and wastewater budgets with the Board advising them of the new test procedures for the water plant. She also reminded the Board that Pilgrim Foods permit application is due on the 14th of July and she will keep them updated.

C. Mary presented the Board with photos and update on the work that was done on the sludge holding tanks. The only items remaining to be done is to decant the system and paint the equipment which she anticipates having done within 2 weeks. She told the Board that Mike Lamarre and Mike Bergeron were very helpful in this project and helped to save the town a considerable amount of money.

Discussion was held concerning the Adams Hill water tank. Board reviewed material that was presented by Carla Mary and after discussion it was agreed that before any final decision to take the tank off line was done they would have the tank inspected and tested for lead paint. Funding for this work will be looked into by Carla Mary.

C. Mary advised the Board that the resident of 84 Mill Street, concerning the sewer line repair, had made contact with her and C. Mary was waiting to hear from her contractor as to when the work would begin, she has not heard anything. Board decided to send the property owner a final letter giving 1 week from the date of the letter to have the work done or the water will be shut off.

Brown Development was scheduled for an 8:00 p.m. appointment but never showed.

Robert Tirrell – Junk Vehicles

R. Tirrell told the Board that he had only 2 junk vehicles and they will be removed this week. The others are antique cars that he is restoring and the hearse that he decorates for Halloween. He has 5 under the tarp that he is working on and plans to put them back on the road. He also has a bus that he uses for storage and fiaro that is registered.

Board discussed that this is an ongoing problem that he has had time to work on. Mr. Tirrell stated that he has been trying to get things done. He does not have the money to pay the fine, or to repair the vehicles right now as his apartment is not currently rented. He also told the Board that he has two parcels of land can he have one on each lot.

Motion made by B. Bergeron, that Robert Tirrell needs to take action on the cease and desist and report back to the board within 1 week of what has taken place or the fines will be assessed, second by S. Blease. Motion carried.

Invoice from Lamarre Concrete

Town received an invoice from Lamarre Concrete for a pipe that was used to repair the drainage problem on Dunster Avenue. The highway department feels that the bill should be paid by the water department as it is the result of a break that occurred in January causing the drainage issue and the water department feels that this is a highway invoice as it has to do with drainage. The cost of the pipe was \$174.00. Board agreed to pay this invoice from the highway department budget.

Salt for 2008 - 2009 season

Dennis Heywood sent a request to be able to purchase the salt needed for the 2008 – 2009 winter season now while prices are still low. S. Blease said that the materials are not ready yet. Board agreed to allow Dennis to see if he can purchase the salt now for delivery later when the product is available.

Budget Process for 2009 budgets

Tom Barrett, member of the Budget Committee, phone earlier in the day with a request from the Budget Committee to start the budget process earlier this year. They would like to send out request to department heads in August with budgets due in by September. Board was in agreement but will discuss details further at their meeting with the Budget Committee on July 23rd.
