August budget was reviewed. Tom Barrett brought up that the town is paying \$4.19 to Fuller but he has checked and received some prices lower. Board will check into this during the week. S. Blease requested that Christine Lavery come in to meet with the Board. She will be scheduled.

Marshall Archambault – Nashua River Watershed Association

M. Archambault stated that he was here to discuss forming an Intermunicipal / Interstate Memorandum of Understanding to promote protection of the Squannacook and Nissitit sub-basins of the Nashua River Watershed. No looking for any action from the Board tonight but seeing if there is interest, it may need to go town meeting to be set up. Board will review the materials that he left and let him know if they have any questions.

Glen Gidley – Pleasant Street Mobile Home Park water and wastewater

Carla Mary also present at this meeting

Glen Gidley met with the Board to discuss his water and wastewater usages and charges. He also told the Board that at one time Charles Buttrick told him that he should look into putting separate meters for each mobile home. This was put on hold while the water project was going on. He also wants to discuss an abandoned mobile home that he would like to get resolved. After reviewing his bills and usage it was agreed to abate his sewer bills to average use for the following bills: 3-15-6, 9-12-06 and 3-13-07.

Mr. Gidley questioned about the vacant mobile home and it is still being taxed. S. Blease told him that it is taxed as long as it is on the property and cannot be removed until taxes are paid.

He asked if they could upgrade their water system and have individual meters. Carla Mary stated that the town does not read individual meters in private parks.

Expendable Trust

Board voted to take \$1,000 from Removing Trees Expendable Trust to pay for the removal of a tree on Old Ashby Road. Request for funds will be sent to the Trustees.
