

Greenville Board of Selectmen
Minutes of the Public Meeting
January 14, 2009

Meeting opened at 7:05 p.m.

FEMA – Ice Storm

Linda Langille reported to the Board the information she received from the meeting in Milford concerning the ice storm in December. She advised the Board that FEMA inspectors will be coming to Greenville to assess the damages and paperwork will begin to be filed for the town to be reimbursed.

Red Flags – water and wastewater

Linda Langille reported to the Board the information she received from a meeting she attended in reference to new federal regulations concerning “red flags” for utilities. She told the Board that the town will need to adopt an Identity Theft Prevention Program by May 1, 2009 and she will be working on preparing this document which will need to be adopted by the Board.

Employee Benefits and Wages for 2009

Motion made by Kathy Washburn to change the sick time benefit for town employees to 8 days per year, personal days to 2 per year and give an increase of 3%, to be effective January 1, 2009, second by Scott Blease. Motion carried 2 in favor 1 abstaining.

Resignation

Board received the resignation of Officer Vint Boggis from Temple-Greenville Police Department. Officer Boggis will be leaving position on January 29, 2009.

2009 Proposed Budget and Warrant Article

Board reviewed the 2009 proposed budget and warrant articles. Board will be meeting with the Budget Committee on Saturday, January 17 to finalize the budget and articles. Board agreed to look into the cost of purchasing a PA System for the town meeting thus reducing the cost of hiring someone to come in and provide this service for the town.

Appointment

Board received request from Marcel Bernier, Emergency Management Director, to appoint Timothy Johnson as the Deputy Director. Kathy Washburn stated that as the Board has not received a written resignation from Candace Fedders she does not want to sign this appointment. Appointment was signed by Scott Blease and Brenda Bergeron.
