

Greenville Board of Selectmen
Minutes of the Public Meeting
January 29, 2009

Members present: Scott Blease, Kathy Washburn, Brenda Bergeron

Meeting opened at 7:08 pm.

Motion made by B. Bergeron to enter into non-public session concerning a legal matter, second by K. Washburn. Motion carried.

Board resumed open session at 7:40 p.m. and voted to seal the minutes of the non-public session.

Carla Mary – Woodard & Curran

Carla Mary reviewed water and sewer proposed 2009 budgets.

Kathy Valliere – Town Clerk/Tax Collector

Kathy Valliere was asked in to discuss her retirement and hours she worked. Board stated that she needs to work 32 hours per week. K. Valliere proposed she work open hours Tuesday and Thursday 9 am to 5 and Wednesday 1 to 8, total of 23 hours open to the public. Board questioned when she would come in to make up the difference in hours and would like to know when those hours are going to be. B. Bergeron stated that the residents need to see her present in the office the hours that the office is open. K. Valliere stated that she will be here 1½ hours Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at the end of the day to close out also. She also stated that she is here additional hours to work on projects. K. Valliere agreed to submit a time sheet showing that she works 32 hours per week, which will begin next week. Posted open hours will not change immediately but when she decides to change them she will advertise the hours. Board agreed and no warrant article will be placed in the 2009 warrant.

Time Clocks

Discussion was held concerning the Board's decision to change the requirement for time clocks. Kathy Washburn stated that she agreed to the decision made not to purchase the time clocks.

Salaries in the Annual Report

Discussion was made on the whether to include salaries in the 2008 annual town report. Scott does not want it to appear in the town report and Kathy does. Board will need to appoint someone to break the tie. Board agreed to appoint Michael Lamarre, former Selectmen to break the tie. Michael Lamarre came to the meeting and was appointed for this vote. Board informed M. Lamarre of what they were looking to do and asked for his input. M. Lamarre voted in favor.

Highway Department Position

Linda Langille told the Board that there are applications coming in for a 20 hour per week highway laborer for the highway department and questioned if the Board is looking to fill this position. Motion made by S. Blease to hire someone for the highway as needed, second by Brenda. Motion carried by a vote of 2 in favor 1 opposed.
