James Lambert – 2009 Town Meeting

James Lambert, Town Moderator, reviewed the proposed 2009 warrant and budget with the Board in preparation for the 2009 annual town meeting. Linda will provide a copy of the amendments that the Board of Selectmen will recommend at town meeting along with a list of those non-residents that will request permission to speak at the meeting.

Board agreed that the Police Department Budget and Article 16, Police Detail Revolving Fund, will be moved to start of the town meeting in order to allow Chief McTague time to give a presentation and answer questions on this items before he needs to leave to attend the town meeting in Temple.

Board agreed to amend the Highway and Streets budget by adding \$30,000 to cover the cost of a chipper.

84 Mill Street – sewer invoice

Motion made by Brenda Bergeron, second by Kathy Washburn to send a letter to Kimberly McLain of 84 Mill Street informing her that this is the town's last request for payment of an invoice for sewer repairs. Failure to either pay the invoice in full or make acceptable arrangements for weekly payments within one week of the date of the letter will result in water being turned off. Motion passed 3 – 0.
