**Chipper**

Board reviewed 2 bids that were submitted for a new chipper. After review it was agreed to purchase the chipper from MB Tractor & Equipment. It was agreed that Linda will ask MB if they are interested in a trade-in for the old chipper. K. O'Keefe stated that she did not want to see anyone else using the new chipper. It was agreed that Mike Bergeron would be placed in charge of the chipper and a crew assigned to him to do the work.

**Ice Storm Damage**

Board discussed how to proceed with the remaining work needing to be done from the ice storm of December 2008. Bids have gone out for the work needed at the playground and cemetery as well as repair the chain link fences at the playground. Bids for clean up will be in next Wednesday and Board agreed that they will look at how the remaining work will be done once they have these costs in and can determine what funds are left to finish up the work.

### **Litter Free NH**

Marshall Buttrick left at the office today a letter from NH the Beautiful concerning the annual town clean up day. For signing up with this program the town can receive two 5-6 foot blight-resistant American elm trees or 800 daffodil bulbs, they would like to receive the daffodil bulbs. Board signed the letter agreeing to receive the bulbs.

### **Building Permits**

It was brought to the Board's attention that currently building permits are being renewed and there is no work in progress. These renewals are continuing for several years without any work being done to the property. Motion made by Scott Blease that no building permit renewals will be allowed, all permits will expire 1 year after date authorized, second by Kelle O'Keefe. Motion carried.

### **Assessment of Land**

Board discussed discrepancies in the assessed acreage of land verses that the property owner claims to have. Board agreed that to set a policy for the town that whenever there is a discrepancy over what the acreage the town is assessing the property for and what the homeowner claims the homeowner will need to supply the town with a survey of the property to determine the correct acreage, no deeds will be accepted for this purpose. This policy is to take effect immediately.
