

**Greenville Board of Selectmen**  
**Minutes of the Public Meeting**  
**March 25, 2009**

Members present: Scott Blease, Brenda Bergeron, Kelle O'Keefe

Meeting opened at 5:00 p.m.

**Bids for Cemetery and Playground Ice Storm work**

Board opened bids for the Cemetery and Playground ice storm clean-up. Bids submitted were as follows: Cemetery – Turilli & Sons - \$28,000; Monadnock Land Clearing - \$15,400; M & L Scrap Metal - \$27,192; GW Shaw - \$29,500 and Foster Logging & Excavating - \$12,840. Playground – Monadnock Land Clearing - \$4,700; Dave's Tree Service - \$2,800 (partial); Turilli & Sons - \$6,800; GW Shaw - \$4,000; Foster Logging & Excavating - \$3,485. Board reviewed and discussed all bids, asking questions of the 2 bids they were considering. Motion made by K. O'Keefe to award the bid for the cemetery work to Monadnock Land Clearing in the amount of \$15,400, second by B. Bergeron. Vote all in favor. Board commented that the reason for this selection was due to Monadnock Land Clearing having 35 years of experience, would be uses 4 – 5 OSHA certified employees, 4 days of prep work, 1 -2 days work and 2 days clean up., met all requirements for insurance. Motion made by K. O'Keefe to award the bid for the playground work to Monadnock Land Clearing, second by B. Bergeron. Vote all in favor. Board commented that the reason for this selection was due to Monadnock Land Clearing having 35 years of experience, using 4 – 5 OSHA certified employees, detailed environmentally safe and plan of what they would do, taking approximately 1 ½ days to complete. Other consideration given was to Foster Logging with owner plus 2 family members and subcontractor, no point made on environmental concerns and not sufficient insurance coverage.

**Dennis Heywood - Highway**

Board told D. Heywood that the chipper would be delivered tomorrow and that they gave the town a \$1,300 trade in for the old chipper. Board also told D. Heywood that they would like Mike Bergeron to be in charge of the chipper and use by the town employees. D. Heywood agreed with the Board. He told the Board that they started today by picking up debris on Temple Street and Ashton Place. K. O'Keefe told him that they would like him and his staff to go through all roads in town and assess what needs to be done as far as clean up including the hangers, list how many days and plan for work to be done giving the Board an action plan of what they are going to do. He can return to the Board on April 8 with this plan and review it with the Board. Discussion was held on how to handle the hangers. D. Heywood asked if there could be a swap of use between Greenville Estates boom truck and the town chipper, with Mike present. Board said that this would be okay as Greenville Estates is willing to assist us. D. Heywood mentioned that he was going to use the loader to raise an employee up with a chain saw to take down the hangers but the Board stated that they do not want the highway employees using the loader to take down the hangers. D. Heywood asked if he can get a hire a sweeper this year for the roads. S. Blease stated that he would let the town use his sweeper for a day at no cost to clear the sidewalks. Motion made by B. Bergeron to accept S. Blease offer, second by K. O'Keefe. Motion carried. D. Heywood stated that this solves the sidewalk but not the road. Board stated that he could hire a sweeper for

the roads as this needs to be done also. K. O'Keefe asked if the light outside the highway garage could be put on a motion sensor so that it is not on all the time. D. Heywood stated that he would take care of it.

### **Emergency Management Room**

L. Langille told the Board that Ed White stated that the Emergency Management room could not be used as a meeting place for departments as there is not 2<sup>nd</sup> means of egress and he is concerned of the equipment that is in that room. Board stated that this room has a second means of egress by going through the other meeting room. As for the equipment these are adults using the room.

### **Transportation Committee**

L. Langille told the Board that she received a call from Myrtle St.Pierre stating that someone is needed to represent Greenville on the Transportation Committee. This Committee provides rides to those in need to get to doctors appointments, etc. Board agreed to place a notice on the cable channel and community channel that someone is needed.

### **Town Clerk-Tax Collector Hours**

Board received a notice from Kathy Valliere that beginning in April she will change her office hours to Tuesday and Thursday – no change, Wednesday 1 – 8 and open the last Saturday of month from 10 to 12. L. Langille asked the Board if they wanted the Selectmen's Office to change the hours they are open to go along with any of her changes and they stated to keep the Selectmen's Office hours the same.

### **Emergency Action Plan**

Scott Blease signed the Emergency Action plan as submitted by Carla Mary for the Water Treatment Plant.
