Minutes of the Public Meeting
May 27, 2009

Meeting opened at 5:00 p.m.

The Board worked on correspondence and reviewed some folders till the first appointment.

Holiday Committee

For the 3rd and 4th of July celebration, the Committee decided to move the street/craft fair to the Town Field. Two permits needed for Pot and Pans Parade and Children Bike Parade. They need to contact the Town Office and the permit will be sent to the State for approval. The Committee talked to Chief McTague about having a cruiser in the lead which is necessary after fireworks to keep people from interfering with traffic. Chief said he has no problem providing services unless they were called away for emergency. The committee asked for the key to the electric box at field. Brenda stated it will be unlocked for that day. The Board told them to submit the amount for invoices and cash needed to the Selectmen's Office.

Southwest Region Planning Commission (SWRPC) – Underwood – Greenville Estate Village District (GEVD)

B. McMaster wanted to inform the Board that he is here for the benefit of the Town, if there are grants available he will be the grant writer. He also stated that the due date for the application is July 27, 2009 and a public hearing needs to be held prior to the application. He also stated if the grant is awarded he will be paid by the grant, if not he will not receive anything.

K. Pratt presented the proposed project. He explained due to G. Estates wells in failure and that the existing supply of water can not meet the maximum usage for a day with one of their wells shut down. A New 12 inch water main from Pleasant Street up to Route 31 to G. Estates which is approximately 11,000 ft. Master Meter Station will be located at their existing treatment building. All construction will be in accordance with Town ordinances and industry standards. K. Pratt said G. Estates has been approved for stimulus funding. Other possibilities are CDBG and ARRA funding. They are asking the Town for consideration of an Intermunicipal Agreement.

T. Barrett said this could be an asset for the Town's future development needs that could occur on Route 31. Also hydrants would be a great benefit to pre-existing and future homes and businesses.

B. Bergeron said that the Board will take this under consideration and will advise Woodard and Curran who represents the Town and will advise the Board on this proposed project.

The Board agreed to attend a joint work session at Greenville Estates on June 11, 2009 at 6 p.m. as they expect more information will be available at that time. Also since the time limit is so closed for the acceptance of the application, B. McMaster asked for consideration of a date and time for public hearing.

Board continued working on paperwork and folders.
