→ Members in attendance:

- ◆ Mo Desrosiers **and** Heather Schoff were not present; however, both indicated they want to work with the Committee.

→ Election of new officers:

- ◆ Chair: Kristy (Motion by Deb, 2nd by Lauren.)
- ◆ Treasurer: Deb Spratt (Motion by Kristy, 2nd by Lauren.)
- ◆ Secretary: Lauren Pashayan (Motion by Deb. 2nd by Kristy.)

→ Treasurer's Report

- ◆ Town allotment - \$2,500.00
- ◆ Committee account - \$2,300.00

→ Garden plots

- ◆ Discussed and assigned to members present as well as to Heather and girl scouts - triangle at High/Main/Temple, and to Mo - triangle by Mill Street.
- ◆ Bridge boxes will be a joint responsibility with rotating watering duty.
- ◆ Members need to sign waivers at Town Clerk's. Kristy will notify us when waivers are ready to sign.
- ◆ Rick has the hose for the library spigot.

→ May 6th deadline for plot clean up.

- ◆ NOTE: Call Scott, Street Department, 603-878-9981, let him know when you will be placing cuttings on the street.

→ May 20th is Spread The Mulch Day.

- ◆ Mulch will be spread again, though less than last year, maybe 6 yards.
  - ◆ The mulch will be purchased from Old Homestead Farm.
  - ◆ Voted to authorized payment up to \$30/yard, not to exceed \$250.00. (Motion by Kristy, 2nd by Rick.)
  - ◆ Plan is to distribute the mulch to each site on May 20th.
  - ◆ Will check to see if fire department volunteers will help again this year.
- Planting plan is to minimize maintenance demands, focus on perennials and bushes, and annuals only for spot color.
- ◆ Purchase at King's Nursery,
  - ◆ Voted to authorized payment not to exceed \$700.00 for flowers and bushes. (Motion by Kristy, 2nd by Deb.)
- Misc
- ◆ Plan fund raising activity for July 4th celebration
  - ◆ Committee agreed to accept the granite bench, donated by Mimi Desaultes.
    - Preferred placement is to replace granite slab on the Town Hall green. Alternative suggestion is to place the granite bench by the river.
    - Will need to check with the Selectman: may we remove the granite block; may we place the granite bench on the Town Hall green. Kristy will arrange to be on the Selectman meeting agenda and let folks know the date.
    - Next meeting: June 26, 2023.
