21	Chairman White began discussion by stating that the applicants for Dollar General were present
22	tonight for some minor site plan modifications.

24	Mr. Turner stated that the modification that they are proposing was a shift in the driveway location.
25 26	He said the driveway was moved further off the road, approximately 20 to 30 feet, due to the presence of rock in the area. He said the contractors did a considerable amount of scraping and found some the
27	rock, therefore, moving the driveway allows them to pick up the driveway approximately one foot. Mr.
28	Turner stated that they are proposing to narrow the driveway and split the difference out back which
29	allows them to be more aggressive with the grades.
