The Chair announced that the Selectmen voted to accept a settlement agreement with Public Service of NH (Eversource) for a refund of \$28,337 to be paid over 3 years with no interest for the tax years of 2015 and 2016.

The Town Administrator provided an update to the Board regarding quotes sought for the sludge removal at the Water Treatment Plant.

The Selectmen reviewed the insurance adjuster's estimate to repair the water damage in the basement. The Town Administrator reported Tandem Construction would not be interested in the job unless it were delayed until January of 2020. A+ Painting would be coming to look at the project soon.
