

Greenville Conservation Commission August 14, 2023 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7 pm. Present were Marshall Buttrick and Stacy DeVal. The minutes from the July meeting were read, and accepted with the following changes: Paragraph 3, remove "and 6 applicants" and "secretary". Add the word "hearing" after "continued". In paragraph 4, Davis Village should read "Davis Village LLC". In paragraph 8, remove "in the woods" and change Taft property to Robert Taft property.

The Souhegan River is higher than usual.

Pilgrim Foods - the EPA has conducted site visits at Pilgrim Foods pursuant to a complaint regarding discharge in the river. EPA found non-compliance with appropriate statutes.

A Cease and Desist order has been issued and a remediation order has been issued. Pilgrim Foods is to comply by August 22, 2023.

Nashua River Watershed Association has released their 2022 water report - it is available on line.

21 Chamberlin Street (No. 6 Mill) Map 5 Lot 132-2 and lot 132 Site Plan Status - the period for public comment and questions has ended. There will be a hearing this Thursday, 8/25/2023.

Davis Village Properties LLC has received conditional approval of their site plan from the planning board.

Trail Maintenance - Marshall has removed the trash bags that were left at the Potter Woods trail. He brought them to the Greenville Town Maintenance Department for proper disposal.

Natural Resources Inventory - Marshall has continued to add information.

New business - Greenville Old Home Days will happen on Saturday, August 26 from 9 am to 3 pm near the Town Pool. Marshall will be speaking on Agriculture in Greenville at noon. We will consider having a booth for the Conservation Commission in the future.
