

Greenville Conservation Commission September 11, 2023 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7pm. Present were Marshall Buttrick, Barbara Guay, and Stacy DelVal. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted.

Souhegan River, Pilgrim Foods/EPA Status - Marshall talked to a contact person at the EPA. Pilgrim Foods has filed remediation documents. These have been shared with the Selectman's Office and the chairman of the Planning Board.

DES has been monitoring the water by the green bridge. A child found a cylinder by the river there and gave it to Marshall, who returned it to DES in Concord - it contained data that was useful to them.

Nashua River Watershed - nothing new to report.

21 Chamberlin Street (No. 6 Mill) - it was moved that the hearing will be continued until September 21.

Natural Resources Inventory - no new information.

New Business - The 2024 Budget is due on October 6th. We will ask for \$750.00, and Marshall will file it tomorrow. Michael Lamarre will be on the planning board agenda next Thursday regarding the expansion of the Hilltop Storage unit.

Stacy DelVal has resigned from the Conservation Commission, effective at the end of 2023.
