Greenville Conservation Commission

The meeting was called to order at 7pm. Present were Marshall Buttrick, Barbara Guay and Stacy DelVal. The minutes from the last meeting were corrected and accepted.

Souhegan River - nothing to report, except that we've had rain and it is slowly rising.

North Branch Walker Brook sign status - not ready yet.

Status of the Doonan Columbian lot survey - The survey has been recorded and final bill sent to the town, and a copy of the survey has been given to the town office. Lot is about 9 acres.

Site plan status for the Dunster Ave "event" venue - there will be a planning board meeting this week.

Budget for 2023 - last year we had a budget of \$600.00, none was spent. We will ask for \$600.00 again . We will need to pay for the Walker Brook sign, also a sign for the land donated by the Doonan.

We have once again been invited to join the NH Assoc. of Conservation Commissions, but have chosen not to join.

Potter Woods - there are some dead beech trees across the trail that need to be moved. We would like to mark the trails with paint - Barbara will check at the hardware store for inexpensive paint.

We reviewed the conservation easements.
