- \* Still Good Shed is only open when there is a Volunteer present. Nothing can be left when Still Good Shed is closed. Police will be notified.**
- \* Only usable, clean items in working order accepted**
- \* Items are for personal use only and not for resale**
- \* You must have a current facility sticker on your vehicle in order to use the Still Good Shed**
- \* Boxes of items will not be accepted  
Items must be unpacked and put neatly on shelves**
- \* Only 5 people allowed in Still Good Shed at a time**
- \* A time limit of 15 minutes will be enforced, with one visit per day per resident or car allowed**
- \* Still Good Shed Volunteers will oversee and have the authority to refuse items deemed unsuitable**
- \* The Town of Wilton takes no responsibility or warrants any item for suitability nor fitness of purpose any item left or taken from the Still Good Shed.**

- \* NO Computer items of any type per State of NH Solid Waste Rules**
- \* NO Large pieces of furniture - ie: couches, mattresses**
- \* NO TVs, VCRs, DVD players**
- \* NO Paints or Chemicals of any kind - ie: pesticides, solvents, automotive fluids**
- \* NO Hazardous Materials or items that contain lithium-ion batteries, lead, mercury, etc.**
- \* NO Weapons of any kind**
- \* NO Textbooks, VHS tapes, or cassettes**
- \* NO Car Seats, Cribs, Helmets**
- \* NO Tires**
