Greenville Conservation Commission June 12, 2023 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Present were Marshall Buttrick, Barbara Guay, and Stacy DelVal. The minutes from our last meeting were read and approved.

Souhegan River - water testing status - there are 3 or 4 less water testing sites than usual - water is tested in the lower part of the river (Amherst and Merrimack).

Nashua River Watershed - Our sign has been installed by Livingston Road.

Review of site plan of 21 Chamberlin Street (No. 6 Mill) There will be a public hearing this Thursday, June 15 at the SAU (formerly Greenville Elementary) at 7pm. Marshall will submit written concerns. Souhegan River Advisory also has concerns. They conducted a preliminary review and sent it to the Greenville Planning Board. Their concerns include inadequate parking, snow storage, run off into the river, and a dumpster at the top of a steep slope.

Davis Village Properties, LLC review of site plan - this is across from the Country Mile on Route 31. The maps that were submitted show an unauthorized building, a garage, size 1,450 square feet.

Natural Resources Inventory - continue

New Business - the Dunster Realty Property, formerly the Antiques Mall, is once again for sale.

There is a right - of - way from Pleasant Street to the former Doonan property that's now part of Conservation Commission property.

There are 2 easements to the Town Forest property available for entrance.

There have been bear, moose, turkey and fox sightings in Greenville.
