Request for Proposals - Fire Station Roof Repair

The Town of Greenville is seeking bids for replacement of the Fire Station roof (gambrel portion only), 7 River Street, Greenville, NH.

Scope of Work:

- Remove and replace shingles and drip edge on gambrel portion of fire station roof properly dispose of old shingles and drip edge. (Ladder and Engine1 Bays)
- Install new wind rated 130MPH+ architectural shingles according to manufacturer's instructions – minimum of 7 nails, no staples.
- Vendors allowed are: GAF Timberline HDZ; Owens Corning Duration, CertainTeed LANDMARK
- Large flat top section of gambrel roof needs to be re-done with appropriate covering. Advise whether or not it is rubber/EPDM, or granular roll material.
- Install synthetic underlayment, and ice and water shield for bottom 6' of roof.
- Install new starter course using starter course shingles
- Install new metal drip edge.
- Care must be taken to prevent any materials from landing in the mill pond. Steps need to be taken to ensure apparatus is not prevented from leaving any bay. Ladder and Engine 1 most impacted.
- Provide a per sheet price, or per square foot price, for replacement of any sheathing that is damaged as a separate cost.

Please provide a statement of qualifications, including any vendor training qualifications or awards you have received, and at least 3 professional references. Upon award, proof of insurance in accordance with town requirements must be provided.
