Article 2: 2023-2024 School District Operating Budget

Shall the Mascenic Regional School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling **twenty million seven hundred ninety-four thousand one hundred twenty-nine dollars (\$ 20,794,129)?** Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be **twenty-million four-hundred ninety-three-thousand four hundred ninety-five dollars (\$ 20,493,495)** which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Mascenic Regional School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only? **Majority vote required to pass. The Mascenic Regional School Board unanimously recommends the passage of this article by a vote of 4 to 0.**

Article 3: Collective Bargaining Agreement

Shall the Mascenic Regional School District approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Board of the Mascenic Regional School District and the Mascenic Educational Support Staff Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing level:

Article 5: Maintenance Equipment Capital Reserve Fund

This sum to come from the June 30, 2023 fund balance available for transfer on July 1, 2023? No amount to be raised from taxation. **Majority vote required to pass. The Mascenic Regional School Board unanimously recommends the passage of this article by a vote of 5 to 0. The Mascenic Advisory Budget Committee unanimously recommends the passage of this article by a vote of 4 to 0.**

Article 6: Food Service Equipment Capital Reserve Fund

To see if the school district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **ten thousand dollars (\$10,000)** to be added to the Food Service Capital Reserve Fund previously established in 2020. This sum to come from the June 30, 2023 fund balance available for transfer on July 1, 2023. No amount to be raised from taxation. **Majority vote required to pass. The Mascenic Regional School Board unanimously recommends the passage of this article by a vote of 5 to 0.**

Article 7: Adoption of Full Day Kindergarten

To see if the Mascenic Regional School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **fifty-nine thousand nine hundred nine dollars (\$59,909)** for the purpose of adopting a full day kindergarten program at Highbridge Hill Elementary School, such sum representing the cost of salaries and benefits for additional staff as offset by a reduction in transportation costs for the 2023-2024 school year? If adopted, the full cost of salaries and benefits will be included in the operating budget in future years.
