

Temple-Greenville Police Department

Traffic Detail Policy

April 9, 2007

The purpose of this policy is to improve public safety by clarifying the requirements for police traffic details on the streets and roads of Temple and Greenville.

The Temple-Greenville Police Department requires at least 24 hours notice prior to any work that interferes with the flow of traffic on any roadway in the towns of Temple or Greenville. The attached "Traffic Detail Notification Form" will be faxed to the Temple-Greenville Police Department by the utility or contractor performing the work. Upon approval, the form will be returned by fax with the bottom portion completed.

A uniformed police officer with cruiser will be required for work on the following roads, unless waived by the Chief of Police. Other locations may require officers or flaggers, as deemed necessary by the Police Chief.

Temple:

Greenville:

The police detail fee will be paid by the contractor or utility company performing the work, as billed by the Temple-Greenville Police Department. The rate for details includes a fee for the officer and cruiser, as well as an administrative fee. The detail rate will be set by the

Temple-Greenville Police Department Joint Board. A four hour minimum payment is required for all required police details.
